TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE:

The Junior Varsity Girls League had 10 teams. They will be divided as follows:

- The structure for the tournament will be a single round robin format with two-game games to 25.
- Teams will earn 1 point for each game they win.
- Tournament games go to 25 points, but you must win by 2, and there are no caps.
- The top 2 teams in each pool will advance to the semi-finals and the semifinal winners will play in the final.
- All play-off matches will be best-of-3 with the tiebreaker going to 15 points. Here too you must win by 2 with no cap.
- Medallions will be awarded to the top two teams.
- Limited warm-ups allowed if the tournament falls behind schedule.
- Triple ball scoring system will be implemented.

TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES:

This system is used to rank teams in a section but is not used to eliminate a team.

- 1. The team having the best ratio of won/lost *matches, considering contests between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- 2. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering contests played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- 3. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering all contests of the round, will be ranked higher;
- 4. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- 5. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played during the round, will be ranked higher;
- 6. As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra game, toss of coin, etc.)
- 7. Any game needed to break ties will be a single game, rally point scoring to 15 points with a two-point difference to determine placing.
 - Matches refers to a "best 2 of 3" or "best 3 of 5" contest.

OFFICIALS:

Referees will be experienced adults, along with trained High School students for Umpires/scorekeepers

LINESMEN:

Schools must provide a knowledgeable linesperson for each game that they play.

COACH & REFEREE'S LOUNGE:

A lounge will be available in the library for all coaches and referees.

LOCAL RULES:

Coaches are responsible for the supervision of their players and are asked to relay the following rules to them.

- Students are not to leave any valuables in the change rooms, as the change rooms will be shared.
- You will need to supply your own warm up balls.
- Teams are to warm up in the gym only, there are to be no balls in the hallways.
- As the bleachers are not pulled out, please advise your players that they are NOT to sit on them. This pulls the supports out of the wall.

ADMISSION (GATE FEE):

- Tournament Pass \$5.00 *
- Day Pass \$3.00
- Sids Free (must be accompanied by their parents)
- * People who purchase a tournament pass must keep their pass with them for both days as the tickets will be punched. Everyone entering the facility must also have a stamp on their wrist.

Even though we are hosting the JV and SV girls, you can only use your tournament pass for <u>one</u> tournament. E.g., If you purchase a tournament pass for the JV tournament it is only good for <u>that</u> tournament. If you are attending both JV and SV tournaments, you will have to purchase a <u>separate</u> pass for each.

AWARDS:

- Medallions will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place finishers.
- The Champions will receive the 2022 COLJHAA banner.

CONCESSION:

There will be a school run concession open to the players and spectators.

LIVE STREAMING:

On Thursday we will be live streaming the bronze and gold medal games on our YouTube channel.

COLJHAA VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE RULE HIGHLIGHTS AND MODIFICATIONS – 2013

Volleyball Canada rules are in effect, except for the following additions or modifications:

- 1. Net heights: JV Girls 6'10"
- 12-man, unlimited sub rule.
 (Players are still "linked for substitution purposes.

Max. 4 subs per link, max. 12 subs per team.)

3. JV Service Rules *

- a. Players can serve overhand or underhand from the baseline.
- b. Players have the option of moving in to serve from a shorter service line (1 meters into court) with the following provisions:
 - underhand attempts only.
 - if a player decides to move back to baseline to serve once then they must serve from there for the remainder of the set.
 - if a player starts the set serving from the baseline, then they cannot move ahead for any attempts in that set.
- 4. Coach movement: net to baseline is allowed.
- 5. Time-outs are 60 seconds, and teams are allowed 2 per game.

^{*} Main court only. We will allow for one step in on the two courts side by side (for OH & UH serves) due to the limited distance between the line and the wall/bleachers.
